Dear Parents,

Please find on the reverse the timetable for Secondary Mock Examinations due to be held from 9<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> January 2012.

Examinations will be as realistic as possible, but to avoid losing too much teaching time the examination period will be restricted to one week. Some subjects will have an extra examination in class time, e.g. oral or listening examinations. Individual subject teachers will inform students about the length of examinations and if there are any extra examinations beyond the examination week. If a student is unclear about when or where an examination is to be held, it is their responsibility to resolve the matter.

When not taking an examination, students may study in the examination hall for another examination or they may leave school provided they present a signed letter from a parent or guardian. Students may not leave school with another student unless their permission letter states that they may. Before leaving school all students must have an 'exit form' signed by Mr Smith, Mr Allen or Ms Downie. Should a student wish to leave school they must do so promptly after an examination, any student remaining in school will be put into the examination hall to study. They must not be found wandering the school buildings, grounds or bring the school into disrepute in the local vicinity. If a student does not have an examination until session 2 it is permitted to come to school for the start of session 2. This is a privilege being offered to Year 11 students only and will be withdrawn should a student be unable to meet these requirements.

Normal lessons will resume on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> January and it essential that all students attend regular lessons from this date.

All students should have made a revision plan for examinations and it is important that students continue with their studies during the school holiday to ensure they achieve the best possible grades in the forthcoming examinations.

I would like to take this opportunity to wish all students good luck in their mock examinations.
